


Certification Exam Policy

The Texas Education Agency (TEA)lows teacher preparation programs to determine where candidate in their respective program mayqualify/has demonstrated readiness to take the TEXES exams heOur Lady of the Lake University Education Department has established the following guidelines and qualifications for teacher education candidates.

Baseline Data & Testing Qualifications

Once admitted into the Teacher Education Admission CoHor(TEACH) program, the candidate will be given access to study materials and practice TExESest(s):

- x Core EG6/Content test and specialization(s) to collect baselinedata for the Education Department.
- x Bilingual Education certification candidates will receive access to study material sefore admittance into Bilingual Education classes to assess their language aptitude/bilingual proficiency and provide support, T(23)4(7)-2.t.2cefo 5 C to(red2IMa




- x Teacher candidates who reside in San Antonio, Texas, must take their practice TExES exams on campus. If they resideoutside the San Antonio area, the andidate must coordinate with the Certification Officer to arrange a date and time for them to complete a practice exam a proctored environment.
- x Teachercandidates must be fully admitted into TEACH and meet the requirements above be authorized to take any of the official certification exams.
- x Demonstrate content knowledge with a passing score on all practice content exams before Clinical Teaching

Study Material

x Students will have access to study materials up to a year after graduation. Should a candidate wish to extend their membership past graduation or use another resource at OLLU, they will be responsible for purchasing these resources.

Testing Support Plan


- a. A candidate who does not pass the officiaTExES exam the first time with a score of 240 (80%) or highwell meet with the Certification Officer to create and sign a Testing Support Plan. The candidates required to complete 100% of the study plan on Certify Teacher or 240 Tutoring antalke the practice TExES exam again with a score of 260 or higher to be released to take the official TExES exam.
- b. If a candidate does not achieve a passing score on the ficial TExES certification exam, they must wait 30 days before attempting to take the test again.

Registering for TExES Certification exams

- a. Effective September 1, 2018, Texas educator candidates will need to create a NEW Pears ting account to register for TExES certification exams by logging into the promotion on the upper right corner of the page, selecting "Create an account now" and following the prompts.
- b. To registerfor a certification exam, go to<u>http://www.tx.nesinc.com</u>, select "Register," and follow the instructions provided. Youmust have created a Pearson testing account and have yourEA (Texas Education Agency)D number to register.
- c. The PearsonTesting website also contains varioustest preparation resources that are free of charge
- d. Testing fees are due when registering for an official certification exam .
